

HUMBLING GENEROSITY. RESTORING HOPE.

Running a camp has a lot to do with problem solving. It's about learning how to prioritize issues as they arise. It's about knowing who to call when something needs repair or replacement. It's about leaning into safety and healthcare protocols for the moments when they will be needed.

When the freezer breaks, the septic backs up, an injury occurs, or a flu bug starts spreading through camp we typically don't miss a beat. We follow our procedures and navigate the challenges as they arise.

However, like most folks, we didn't have a policy, protocol, or procedure to navigate a pandemic. We didn't have a playbook for how to respond to the cancellation of an entire year's worth of programming, and the idea of two years without camp, day camp, or hotel-based events was beyond our ability to comprehend.

Yet here we are.

If you had asked me in 2014 or earlier if Living Water Ministries could have survived the loss of two consecutive summer camp seasons I would have unhesitatingly told you that we could not. The loss of revenue from camper fees, a relatively under-developed donor base at the time, a deficit budget and the six-figure debt load we were carrying would have meant catastrophe.

But catastrophe has not been our experience during these challenging times. In fact, the opposite has been true. In 2020 we experienced a 108% increase in fundraising over the year prior. We've also been fortunate to receive two PPP loans, and have benefited from interest income from our ELCA Pooled Trust investment which holds the proceeds from the sale of Michi-Lu-Ca.

Financially, Living Water Ministries has thus far navigated this pandemic without incurring any losses while preserving our reserve funds, and maintaining employment for our year-round staff without interruption. Because of this financial stability, the generosity

of our donors, and significant gifts received from lead congregations, we've also been able to move forward with phase 1 of our facility renewal plan through the construction of a new duplex cabin that will be operational for our 2022 summer season!

This pandemic has and continues to turn the world upside-down. The losses for many have been immense. Here, the stillness of camp has been haunting. However, in the midst of the heaviness we have been extremely humbled by the generosity we've received from the Living Water Ministries community, and through that generosity we have been able to maintain our focus on hope instead of survival.

We are planning our official return to programming in January of 2022 with our hotel-based event known as the Great Lakes Gathering for high school students and young adults. While our mission has been alive and well during these strange times, we're excited about the possibility of returning to in-person experiences where we see that mission play out in the way God shows up in the hearts and lives of the people we serve.

Until that time, your renewed generosity is invited, welcomed, and greatly appreciated. Our hope is to navigate the remainder of 2021 with the goal of avoiding financial loss so that our attention can be focused on preparing for the glorious, problem solving work of camp in 2022.

\$5K/5KA SUCCESS

Bringing together all of God's children for experiences of service, leadership, and community has been a challenge during the pandemic. However, in May of 2021 the Living Water Ministries community showed up big for our first virtual 5K event in support of our scholarship fund.

While there are no summer programs occurring at camp in 2021, our scholarship fund will be a critical component of our camper recruitment strategy heading in to our 2022 summer season. Runners, walkers, and rollers from all over the country chose hope as they participated in the \$5K/5K, making a way for campers who otherwise would not be able to attend the programs we offer.

Even though we couldn't meet in person, the \$5K/5K certainly created a faith-filled community of leaders practicing service in the hopes that both lives and the world might be transformed. The mission and vision of Living Water Ministries is certainly alive and well.

In the fall of 2020, Living Water Ministries introduced our new recurring giving program - The Stream. LAYING A FOUNDATION FOR HOPE.

In February of 2021, the Living Water Ministries Board of Directors approved the implementation of phase one of our five phase facility renewal plan. Bids were solicited, a contract was signed, and construction of our first duplex cabin is underway!

This duplex cabin will feature electric baseboard heat, in-cabin bathrooms with private toilets and showers, and a great room equipped with a kitchenette. Once completed, this facility will house up to 24 people with bunk-style accommodations.

Hope is being restored at Living Water Ministries as we dream about, plan for, and literally construct a new foundation for camp programs at Stony Lake in 2022 and beyond!

PHASE 1 • 2020-2022 PHASE 2 • 2022-2025

Phase 1 & 2 focus on the fundraising and construction of two duplex style cabins with shared meeting space.

Cabin 1 groundbreaking scheduled for Spring of 2021. Cabin 2 groundbreaking scheduled for Fall of 2024.

Estimated Construction Costs Per Cabin: \$400,000.00

PHASE 3 • 2025-2029

Phase 3 focuses on the fundraising, renovation, and expansion of the Dining Hall. Dining Hall renovations and expansion scheduled for Fall of 2028.

Estimated Dining Hall Costs: \$1,000,000.00

PHASE 4 • 2029-2033 PHASE 5 • 2033-2037

Phase 4 & 5 focus on the fundraising and construction of four duplex style cabins; two during each phase. Cabin 3 & 4 groundbreaking scheduled for Fall of 2032. Cabin 5 & 6 groundbreaking scheduled for Fall of 2036.

Estimated Construction Cost Per Phase: \$750,000.00
